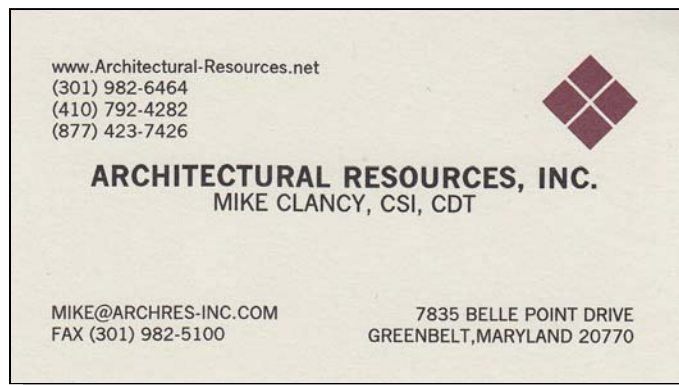

SUMMARY OF MAY 2016 NOVA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

1. **Call to Order:** John Geniesse, President Elect, called the May 2016 regular meeting of the Board of Directors to order on Wednesday, 13 April 2016 at 5:05 pm at the Washington-Dulles Airport Marriott Hotel.
2. **Committees**
 - a. *Programs* - Cynthia Heimann, Chair
 - 1) The September program on automated door operators is confirmed by John Geniesse.
 - 2) Potential program topics were proposed:
 - a) "The Wharf" mixed-use SE DC waterfront destination project and architectural teams.
 - b) MGM National Harbor casino resort development.
 - b. *Finance* - Diane Pittman, Chair
 - 1) Diane will need to provide financial information to the audit committee (Jesse, Mike M., Tom, and Luigi) then establish a teleconference or meeting to perform the audit.
 - 2) If auditors are available, the audit may be conducted before the June business meeting.
 - c. *Awards* - Bill Rains, Chair
 - 1) Bill has provided a preliminary list of awards to John and Jesse for review.
 - a) Bill needs to prepare the actual awards before the June event meeting.
 - d. *House* - Bob Trafton, Chair
 - 1) 19 Guests are pre-registered for tonight's dinner.
 - 2) Bob reported the CSI database shows NOVA membership at 60.
 - e. *Historian and Digital Records* - Deb MacPherson, Chair
 - 1) Bob reported that he has possession of the historical records for the chapter and is slowly sorting and scanning the documents for digital retention.



3. 2015 - 2016 Chapter Program Schedule (Presenter or sponsor in parentheses)

- a. *June*: 3rd Annual NOVA CSI Hors D'oeuvres, Desert & Awards
- b. *July*: Summer Planning Meeting – Location TBD
- c. *August*: No Meeting
- d. *September*: Stanley "Automated Operators", (John Geniesse)

4. Old Business

- a. *MARC 2018*:
 - 1) David reported that the original hotel contract proposal has been reviewed and several amendments were requested.
 - a) The updated version was not sent to David until today and arrived while he was traveling to the board meeting. Therefore, printed documents were not available.
 - b) A \$2000 advance payment has been received from MAR and a chapter check made out to the Washington Hotel has been prepared for payment after the contract has been signed.
 - 2) David intends to appoint several committee chairs for various components of the conference from volunteers that registered at the April meeting.
 - 3) NOVA will need to raise approximately \$35,000 to meet the budget requirements. Based on historical fundraising efforts, this appears to be attainable.
 - 4) The 24-month schedule provided by the committee is generally on track. Announcements and advertising for MARC 2018 are progressing accordingly.
- b. The 3rd Annual NOVA CSI Hors d'Oeuvres, Desserts and Awards
 - 1) Mike Clancy reported that 15 vendors had been committed but one has dropped and Tremco may also be unable to sponsor a table.
 - a) Alan will determine whether his firm will sponsor a table.
 - 2) Advertising with other organizations has had mixed success with Northern Virginia AIA including our event in its newsletter. Mike will see if other chapters can include our event in their newsletters.
 - 3) Debit card door prizes will be drawn. Mike proposes \$100 Grand Prize and \$50 prizes to be drawn throughout the event. The grand prize drawing will be at 8:00 pm.
 - 4) NOVA will sponsor two glasses of wine for each guest who registers in advance.
 - 5) Music is still an issue to be resolved.
- c. Chapter SOP – Needs to be simplified with each board member/officer responsible to review appropriate sections. Jesse emphasizes this action as an ongoing requirement.



5. **Adjournment** - President Elect Geniesse declared the meeting adjourned at 5:53 pm. ❖
